Health Services

Library

The library is available to all students currently participating in a clinical rotation at All Saints. The Librarian is available to assist you during regular library hours. The All Saints Library is located in the main hospital building on the Spring St. Campus.

Lockers

Depending on the area / site the clinical rotation takes place, lockers may be available. Cafeteria

Cafeteria services are available at the Spring St. and Wisconsin Avenue campuses. Students are welcome to use the cafeteria. The cafeteria serves a variety of food daily until 6:30pm. Vending services are located near the cafeteria on both campuses. A microwave is also available for use.

Parking

Because parking space is limited at both All Saints campus facilities, students are encouraged to carpool whenever possible. If at the Wisconsin Avenue campus, students may also park on the street in the public parking spaces surrounding the campus buildings. Students and Instructors **MAY NOT** utilize the staff parking areas in front of the St. Luke's Pavilion or behind the Professional Building on the Spring St. Campus. **Students may never park in spaces designated for patients and visitors, clergy, or physicians.** All Saints is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles.
